

# Bye Law 9: Licensing (Clubs) (Scotland) Regulations 2017



For the avoidance of any doubt, the preceding text of the Articles of Association of the Students' Association of the University of the West of Scotland, in conjunction with any of its bye-laws and regulations, shall be read and understood to include the following provisions:

1. No member of the committee or other governing body and no person employed by the club is to have any personal interest in the sale of alcohol on the club premises or in the profits arising from such sale;
2. Other than when an occasional license has effect, no person is to be supplied with alcohol on the club premises unless that person is-
  - a. A member of the club;
  - b. A person who is on the premises at the invitation of a member of the club and is accompanied by that member; or
  - c. A member of another club which falls within the description prescribed in paragraph 1;
3. Where a person referred to in sub-paragraph (2)(b) is supplied with alcohol on club premises when an occasional license is not in effect, there is to be entered in a book kept for the purpose-
  - a. The date in question;
  - b. The name and address of the person; and
  - c. The name of the member accompanying the person;
